- The Clerk's Office is requesting the use of the drop box or U.S. Mail for returning all Absentee Voter Applications.
- The Department of Public Work has suspended all non-emergency appointments but will be responding as always to emergency calls.
- The Police Department will still be open Monday through Thursday from 11am – 4pm. Please only come in if you need to get a car released from impound. For all other questions or concerns please call the office at 810-686-4400 during office hours or call 911.
- All public meetings during this time have been cancelled.
- These measures are being put into place to protect the health, safety, and welfare of our residents and employees. All of these preventative measures will be in effect through April 5, 2020, at which time we will reevaluate the situation.
